

A Special meeting of the Council was held Tuesday December 10, 1935, 8 O'Clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mavor Vinvard, City Atty. Wait, Chief of Police Atwood, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Bates, Cutsforth, Giger, Hornig, Koehler, Porter and Thompson. Councilman Rothenberg, absent.

Mayor Vinvard stated the meeting had been called to consider the building of a new City Hall and Fire House.

Motion was made and seconded that the following Resolution be adopted. A Resolution calling for an Ordinance, submitting to the legal voters of Canby, Oregon, at a Special Election to be held in Canby, Oregon, on January 31, 1936, for their approval or rejection, the question as to whether Canby shall construct and build, a building for the use of the City of Canby, a City Hall and Fire House. Motion carried.

Motion was made and seconded, that an Ordinance providing for the calling and holding of a Special Election on January 31st. 1936, be passed on first reading and ordered published. Motion carried.

Ordinance #75 providing for the construction of Cement Sidewalks was read by the Recorder. On motion, seconded and carried, Ordinance # 75 was passed on first reading and ordered published.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
