A letter from the State Industrial accident commission was read, stating, that they were opening a seperate account for S.E.R.A. project and that the insurance rate for improving the lighting system would be \$5.00 per \$100.00 payroll. Mr.Koehler reported there is work obtainable for an S.E.R.A. project. Some drainage ditches and drywells to be dug and sidewalks should be looked after. Also states that the Bridges property should be cleaned up.

Ordinance No.68 was introduced, and on motion, seconed and carried was duly declared passed on its first reading and ordered published. On motion, seconded and carried, the Council then adjourned.
