City Treasurer John Eid submitted his quarterly report for the period ending March 31st.1935.On motion seconded and carried his report was accepted subject to audit of the Finance Committee.

An Auditors Report from Mr.J.P. Telford covering 1934 business was then read by the Recorder. Mr Lent stated that recommendations by the Auditor, in regard to records in the Light & Water Dept. had been adopted.

Ordinance #69 then came up for final action. On motion, seconded and

On motion, seconded and carried, the Council offered a \$25.00 Reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of anyone for destroying or defacing Public Property.

Mr.C.C.Marks then addressed the Council, requesting that the Council reconsider approval of his Beer License. On motion, seconded and Carried the Council reconsidered application of C.C.Marks for Beer license.

On motion made and seconded, to approve C.C. Marks application for Beer License. Motion declaired rejected.

On motion seconded and carried Council adjourned.
