#### PROCLAMATION.

I, J.R.Vinyard, Mayor of the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, do hereby Proclaim and Declair, that at the Regular General City Election, held in Canby, on November 6th 1934, the Official returns of said Election were duly canvassed by the City Council of Canby on the 8th day of Nov. 1934, and the result of said Election was found by said City Council, to be as follows, to wit;

For the office of Mayor for the term of two years;

Total number of votes cast 274, J.R.Vinyard received 274.

For Councilmen for the term of four years.

Total number of votes cast 1137.

On the question as to whether the Council of Canby should call an Election to submit to the voters of Canby, the question as to whether Canby should have a State Liquor Store or not.

THEREFORE? by vertue of the returns of said Election, and the canvass of the vote thereof by the City Council of Canby Oregon,

I, Declare; That J.R.Vinyard is duly elected Mayor for the ensuing term of Two years, and that W.H. Thompson, George Koehler, Harry Porter and August Rothenberg are elected Councilmen for the ensuing term of four years, and that J.A. Giger is elected Councilman for the ensuing term of Two years. And I further Declare, that the question voted on as to whether the Council should call an election on the question as to whether Canby should have a State Liquor Store or not, was decided against the calling of said Election.

I further Declare, that John Eid is elected City Treasurer for 2 years. Canby Oregon, November 8th 1934.
