On motion, seconded and carried Mr. Porter was instructed to have have Mr. Piatt cut the grass on the streets where necessary.

Mayor Vinyard reporting on the F.E.R.A .projects reported that maps had been made and that some action on these projects could be expected soon. The committee working on the cemetary deal were asked to investigate this matter thouroughly and report at the next meeting of the Council.

On motion, seconded and carried Mr.Lent was instructed to paint the rroof of the new pump house with coal tar.

There being no further business the Council then adjourned.
