

A meeting of the Council was held on Monday July 16th at 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Lent, Recorder Fosmark and Councilmen Bates Cutsforth, Koehler, Gribble, Hornig, and Porter. Meeks and Thompson reported later. Absent Atty. Wait.

Mayor Vinyard stated that the meeting was being held to consider the bids on furnishing 2" pipe and digging ditch and laying the pipe.

The Notice calling for bids was then read by the Recorder, whereupon the bids were opened and read as follows.

For furnishing Pipe:

Canby Hardware & Impiment Co. 2" National Galv. Pipe \$24.52 per 100 Ft.
Carlton & Rosenkrans Co. 2" Galv. Pipe at \$ 23.25 per 100 Ft.

For digging ditch 3ft deep laying pipe and backfill.

R.S.Funk .75 per rod

E.I.Piatt .75 per rod.

Faulkner & Thomas, .66 per rod

Joe Lent .70 per rod with Insurance cost to be added

P.A.Sime \$3.95 per 100 ft.

R.M.Weygandt \$ 74.00 with Insurance to be added.

Donald H.Stumm \$147.60

After due consideration it was moved, seconded and carried that the contract of digging ditch and laying the pipe, be awarded to R.M.Weygandt the City allowing the cost of insurance to his bid on labor. The Water committee was authorized to award the contract for furnishing the pipe after investigating the grade of pipe bid on and the possibility of giving immediate delivery.

Mr. Lent stated that the foot valve on the water pump was giving trouble and that a different kind of valve would be required, and that the old valve could be credited for about \$ 13.00 on a new one priced at about \$34.00 On motion, seconded and carried Mr. Lent was authorized to secure the new valve.

There being no further business the Council then adjourned.
