Reports:

Mr. Lent reported that an engineer from the General Electric Co had examined the pump motor in regard to it heating, and that it had been pronounced safe to operate under the present conditions. He also reported that the new float valve and check valve had been installed and were working satisfactory. He stated further that he had connected the pumping plant for R. MacKinzie and that an electric stove would be connected for Mr. Lee in a few days. He also stated that the Company heating road oil are now using about 100 cubic Ft. of water per day, and that it would be possible for the City to take road oil in exchange for this water. Fire Chief Larson reported that a small fire had occurred during the month, and that it had been extinguished before any damage was done. He stated further that Mr. Lamb had not cleaned up after removing the Miss. Bridge house. The committee was instructed to have this matter attended to. Mr. Bates reported that in awarding the contracts for the water pipe and ditch that Mr. Weygant had refused to sign his contract. and the committee had awarded the contract to Thomas & Faulkner the next low bidders. and that they could not determine satisfactory as to the grade of pipe bid on by C. & R Co. so the contract had been awarded to Canby Hdw. & Implement Co. the next low bidders. On motion seconded and carried the Council sanctioned the action of the water committee in awarding these contracts.

Mr. Lent then asked that he be given a week of his vacation this month. Mayor Vinyard stated that the Night watchman had also asked to take a vacation. after some discussion this mater was left to the committee to arrange the dates.

Attorney Wait stated that it would be necessary to appoint a Budgett committee at this time and recommended that said committee would meet with the Council on August 17 th. whereupon Mayor Vinyard appointed the following Budgett committee A.H.Knight, Ed. Krueger, A.S.Markee, Wilmer Sandsness G.W.White and George Cattley.

There being no further business the Council then adjourned.
