

A Special meeting of the Council was held on Thursday Aug. 30th. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Wait, Chief of Police Lent, Recorder Fosmark and Councilmen Bates, Cutsforth, Koehler, Hornig, Porter and Thompson. Absent Gribble and Meeks.

Mayor Vinyard stated that the meeting had been called to meet with the Budget committee to consider the proposed levy and declare the Budget for the year 1934. Whereupon the proposed levy was read by the Recorder. After some discussion it was decided that the sum of \$200.00 be added to the Emergencies fund to help take care of expense of the tennis courts at the High school. With this change made it was moved, seconded and carried that the budget be adopted.

A. H. Knight then addressed the Council recommending that the minimum charge on water be reduced to give the small consumers who wished to to save a chance to do so. After much discussion this matter was left to the water committee for consideration.

There being no further business the Council, then adjourned.
