

REGULAR MEETING

THE REGULAR Monthly meeting of the City Council was held Monday June 5th. 1933. At 8:00'clock P.M.

On roll call there were present Mayor Dedman, City Attorney Wait, Chief of Police Lent, Recorder Fosmark and Councilmen Bates, Cutsforth, Dimick, Hornig, Porter, and Thompson. Graham and Meeks reported later. Minutes of last regular and special meeting were read and approved. A letter from Hal E. Hossain in reply to the City's request for a man to conduct examinations for applicants of new drivers licenses was now read. also a letter from Ralph C. Clyde inviting the Council to attend the grand opening of Dodge Park and Annex on June 11th.

A letter from Ben S. Morrow of the Portland Water Bureau regarding Powdered Activated Carbon as a water purifier was now read, also a letter from McIntosh & Seymour Corporation regarding Diesel engines. After some discussion it was decided to try to send a delegation to Dodge Park on June 11th.

On motion by Bates and Seconded by Cutsforth the above claims were allowed Yeas 8 Nays 0

Reports

Mr. Lent reported that he had changed the transformer on the electric line leading to the May's property, and that he had flushed out the water mains several times and discontinued the use of the shallow well thereby trying to eliminate the bad odor and roiley condition of the water, but the water still remains bad. Mr. Larson suggested that a pumper from the Oregon City fire Department be secured to pump the mains out. The possibility of securing a new water supply for the City was now brought up and after much discussion it was decided that the Councilmen would get together on Thursday afternoon to go and view the possibilities of a new reservoir on the Salomon or Hurias property.

Mrs. W.H. Thompson now addressed the Council in behalf of the Camp Fire Girls she stated that the girls had done much work towards beautifying a triangle piece of ground near the Wait place and that they wished to give this work to the City in exchange of water piped to this plat of ground and light furnished at their place of meeting. On Motion, Seconded and carried this matter was left to the water committee to arrange for the water for this plat and the City offer it's co-operation to the Camp Fire Girls.

The matter of Filling the Irrigation ditch was now brought up, and after much discussion the Recorder was instructed to send Mr. Blazier a copy of Resolution adopted by the Council on June 6th 1932, Dating same as of this date.

There being no further business the Council adjourned.
