THE REGULAR Monthly meeting of the City Council was held Monday June 5th. 1933. At 8'0'clock P.M.

A letter from Ben S.Morrow of the Portland Water Bureau regarding

Powdered Activated Carbon as a water purifier was now read, also a letter from McIntosh & seymour Corporation regarding Diesel engines. After some discussion it was decided to try to send a deligation to

Dodge Park on June 11th.

Reports

Mr.Lent reported that he had changed the transformer on the electric LINE-leading to the May's property, and that he had flushed out the water mains several timesand discontinued the use of the shallow well thereby trying to illiminate the bad offer and roiley condition of the water, but the water still remains bad. Mr.Larson suggested that a pumper from the Oregon City fire Deartment be secured to pump the mains out. The possibility of securing a new water suply for the City was now braught up and after much discussion it was decided that the Councilmen would get togather on Thursday afternoon to go and view the possibilities of a new resevour on Thursday afternoon to go and view the possibilities of a new resevour on the Salomom or Hurias property.

Mrs. V.H. Thompson now addressed the Council in behalf of the Camp Fire Girls she stated that the girls had done much work towards beautifying a triangle piece of ground near the Wait place and that they wished to give this work to the City in exchange of water piped to this plat of ground and light furnished at their place of meeting. On Motion, Seconded and carried this matter was left to the water comittee to arrange for the water for this plat and the City offer it's co-opreation to the Camp Fire Girls.

The matter of Filling the Irrigation ditch was now braught up, and after much discussion the Recorder was instructed to send Mr. Blazier a copy of Resoloution adopted by the Council on June 6th 1932, Dateing same as of this date.

There being no further business the Council adjourned.
