

Special Meeting
Octo. 24, 1932

The Council met in special session on Monday, October 24, 1932 at 8 o'clock P.M.

On roll call there were present: Mayor Dedman, Attorney Wait, Chief of Police Lent, Recorder H.B. Evans, and Councilmen Bates, Dimick, Koehler, Meeks, Patch, Porter and Thompson. Absent, Councilman Graham.

The Mayor announced that the Council had convened to meet with the Budget Committee to discuss and adopt a budget for the following year.

Before proceeding with the vote on the budget, and in connection with the item of \$ 1000. for the Fire Department, Fire Chief Larson introduced E.A. Taylor and Geo. W. Stokes from the State Fire Marshall's Department.

Mr. Taylor spoke at some length, with reference to fire fighting equipment, organization, etc., and stated that the department was ready at all times to give information or aid, if it should be called upon.

Whereupon the following budget was agreed upon, and on motion seconded and carried, adopted by a joint vote of the Council and Committee.

On motion, seconded and carried, it was then adopted by the Council, and the City Attorney instructed to prepare the necessary Ordinance to be introduced at the next regular meeting.
