Reports.

Mr. Lent reported the installation of the new pump. Also blowing out of fuse resulting in burned out motor in pump house. In connection with this, the Light Committee was instructed to look into the matter of trouble caused by P.E.P. lines.

Mr. Larson reported having received some new equipment, with more to come.

He also stressed the need of more fire ladders, the necessity of cleaning up old properties which constituted a fire hazard, and thought a building ordinance should be passed. He also bro't up the matter of calling for outside assistance when the department is fighting fire, and it was decided by the Council, that this should only be done by some one in authority.

Whereupon the matter of the irrigation ditch problem between the Catholic Church and the H.N.Brown property was again mentioned, and Mr. M.J.Lee being present, promised to correct the same.

Whereupon the Recorder read a proposed dog Ordinance, for the purpose of disposing of stray dogs and fining the owners, etc., but some of the members believing that this matter was already covered by old Ordinance, it was voted to lay it over for further investigation by the City Attorney.

Whereupon on motion, seconded and carried it was voted to empower the Committee on Light and Power to authorize minor improvements without waiting to bring them before the regular meetings of the Council.

The following Ordinance then came up for final action, and on motion, seconded and carried placed on its final passage.

On roll call the vote stood, Yeas 7-nays 0.

Whereupon the Mayor announced the Ordinance duly passed.

ORDINANCE NO. 46-1931

An ordinance providing for an Auditing Committee for the City of Canby and to provide for the presentation of all claims against the City of Canby to such committee and for the committee to report to the City Council before payment, repealing all ordinances in conflict herewith:

CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Auditing Committee of the City of Canby shall consist of the following officials of the City: The Chairman of the Finance Committee, the City Recorder, the City Treasurer and the Superintendent of the Water and Light Department.

Section 2. The Auditing Committee of the City of Canby shall act as the Accounting Officers of the City. All demands, accounts or claims against the City shall be presented to the committee with the necessary evidence and support thereof and said committee shall examine and audit the same and if it finds such demand, account or claim correct, lawful, just or valid, shall indorse them as audited and approved, and report them at the next regular meeting of the City

Council of Canby together with the suggestions and explanations as the Committee may deem proper, and if a demand, claim or account and the evidence in support thereof is not sufficient to satisfy it as to its correctness, justness or validity, the Committee shall endorse the same with such additional information as they may think necessary.

The Committee will monthly furnish the Council of Canby with a list of approved claims to which list shall be attached the audited claims so presented, and a second list of rejected claims attached thereto and may attach to said lists such additional information as they may desire. The said lists so presented shall be divided into claims against the various departments of the City Government as may have been made heretofore by the City Council or may hereafter be made.

Section 3. That all claims shall be filed with the City Recorder not later than Three o'clock p. m. on the First

Monday of the month in which the claimant desire the same to be paid.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
