June 3, 1931

The above claims, having been approved by the Auditing Committee, on motion, seconded and carried, were allowed and warrants ordered drawn.

Reports.

Mr. Lent reported that the new pump was giving good service.

Fire Chief Larson reported that the convention of fire marshalls would soon be held at Corvallis, and asked for permission to attend at the expense of the City. On motion, seconded and carried, the above was granted.

Whereupon Water Bonds # 37 to # 49 both inclusive, amounting to \$ 6500.00, having been retired by the City Treasurer were destroyed by fire.

Whereupon on motion of Graham, seconded by Meeks and carried, it was voted that the Electric Light Committee and the Light Superintendent be authorized to engage the services of a competent engineer to make a test of the Molalla Electric Co. meter serving the City of Canby.

Whereupon it was moved by Patch, seconded by Porter, that the City Recorder be instructed to write to the Molalla Electric Co. notifying them to string another wire through Canby to serve their outside customers.

There being no other business, the meeting adjourned.
