

Regular Monthly Meeting
Sept. 8-1931

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held on Tuesday, September 8, 1931 the previous Monday being a holiday.

On roll call there were present: Mayor Dedman, Attorney Wait, Chief of Police Lent, Recorder H.B. Evans, and Councilmen Bates, Dimick, Graham, Koehler, Meeks, Patch, Porter and Thompson.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Whereupon the Recorder read the report of Mr. L. E. Kurtchanoff covering the testing and installation of the new meter placed by the Molalla Electric Co.

Mr. Hanlon of the Public Utilities Commission also read a lengthy report covering the same.

He also spoke of traffic violations which should be embodied in Ordinance, namely, speeding and turning between intersections.

Whereupon the matter of speeding through the City on the Highway was discussed, and Mayor Dedman suggested that the Street Committee inform itself as to our rights, and see what can be done.

Whereupon Attorney Wait reported not having yet secured any rebate of taxes on the property recently taken in by the City.

In the matter of oiling the road to the Fair Grounds, the City being asked to help defray the expense, the County furnishing the oil, the Council was favorable, the cost to be about \$ 10.00.

Whereupon on motion, seconded and carried, the following citizens were appointed to serve on a Budget Committee to prepare a budget for the coming year.

Whereupon Mr. Lent suggested that the city well should be cleaned out, (and was instructed to have it done.)
