An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 135, entitled an Ordinance providing for licensing and regulating the carrying on of certain professions, trades, callings or occupations carried on within the corporate limits of Ganby, Oregon, and providing a penalty for the violation of this ordinance; and the repealing of all ordinance; and the repealing of all ordinances in conflict herewith.

Canby Does Ordain as Follows:

That ordinance No. 135 be amended to include among the occupations subject to pay a license for the right to operate within the corporate limits of Canby, as follows:

Any person or persons operating a wood sawing machine for hire, with any machine run or operated by power within the corporate limits of Canby, Oregon, shall pay to the city of Canby the sum of ten dollars per year as a license fee for such right. Said license fee to be paid on the first day of January of each year, and any person wishing to operate any such machine for the balance of the year 1930, after this ordinance goes into effect, shall pay \$2.00 for such right to operate said machine for the balance of the year 1930, after this ordinance goes into effect, shall pay \$2.00 for such right to operate said machine for the balance of the year, 1930.

Read first time at a regular meeting of the city council Monday, November 3, 1930.


Special Meeting. October 27-1930
