

Regular Meeting  
Dec. 1-1930

The City Council met in regular monthly session on Monday, December 1, 1930 at 8 o'clock P.M.

On roll call there were present: Mayor Dedman, City Attorney Wait, Chief of Police Lent, Recorder H.B. Evans and Councilmen Bates, Graham, Patch, Pfister, Thompson and Zimmerman. Councilman <sup>Wait</sup> reported later.

The minutes of the previous meeting of November 3, and those of the meeting of November 6 were read and approved.

## Reports.

Mr. Lent reported that the pump had been taken out and found to be in good condition, but that the noise had not been corrected.

He also reported the completion of the Weed Street light extension and the Watson extension about to be started. It was decided to postpone the Fair Grounds extension at present.

Whereupon the special committee appointed to confer with Mr. Griffith on rates announced it was not ready to report, and the Committee was continued.

Whereupon Mr. Pfister asked for additional street lighting on Third Street, and on motion, seconded and carried, it was voted to install a light at the Shull corner.

Whereupon the following Ordinance came up for final action, and on motion, seconded and carried declared passed on its final passage: Yeas 7-nays 0.

**ORDINANCE NO. 45—Series 1930**  
An Ordinance for the purpose of levying a tax on all taxable property, both real and personal, within Canby.

**CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS; TO-WIT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Council of the City of Canby, does hereby levy a tax of \$5308.42 on all the taxable property, both real and personal which is taxable for County and State purposes, within the Corporate limits of Canby, which is to be collected as other taxes are collected in the State of Oregon, by the Sheriff and tax collector of Clackamas County, during the year 1931, with the tax known as the taxes of 1930.

Said levy shall consist of \$3355.00 known as the regular City tax, and \$1953.42 special tax heretofore approved by the voters of Canby. Repaid for the first time at a regular meeting of the Council, held on November 3rd, 1930, and ordered published. To come up for final hearing at a regular meeting of the Council to be held December first, 1930.
