Whereupon the Mayor stated that the next order of business would be the election of a Councilman to fill the vacancy caused by the change of residence of Mr. Weygandt, who automatically became disqualified by moving from the City.

B.P.Pfister and Otto Krueger were nominated, and on ballotting, Mr. Pfister received 4 votes and Mr. Krueger 3.

Whereupon the Mayor announced that Mr. Pfister had been elected to the Council to serve until the next general election.

Whereupon it appearing that the City Fire truck should be equipped with a self starter, it was moved seconded and carried that it should be installed as soon as possible.

On motion, seconded and carried, the Council then adjourned.

Regular Monthly Meeting April 1-1929

The Council met in regular session on Monday, April 1, 1929 at 8 o'clock P.M.
