

## Regular Meeting

May 6-1929

The Council met in regular session on Monday, May 6, 1929 at 8 o'clock P.M.

On roll call there were present : Mayor Dedman, City Attorney Wait, Chief of Police Lent, Recorder H.B.Evans and Councilmen Bates, Graham, Patch, Pfister, Thompson, White and Zimmerman. Councilman Koehler reported later.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Whereupon the Recorder read a communication from Mr. Cattley asking the City to take some action relative to changing the location of the electric light pole on the Pacific Highway at his corner. No action.

Whereupon a number of ladies representing the W.C.T.U. being present, they were asked to state their business, if any. Mrs. Waldron acted as spokesman and stated that they were present for the purpose of securing the aid of the City Government in bringing about better conditions relative to places of amusement, the fracturing of various laws and especially to remonstrate against the use of bill-boards for advertising cigarettes on which women were featured.

The Mayor announced that the matter would be given due consideration.
