

August 6-1928

The Council met in regular session on Monday, Aug. 6, 1928 at 8 P.M.

On roll call there were present, Mayor Bair, Attorney Wait, Chief of Police Lent, Recorder H.B. Evans and Councilmen Garrett, Graham, Koehler, Shewey, White and Zimmerman. Councilman Dedman reported late and was excused after a few minutes attendance. Councilman Patch absent.

The records of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Whereupon the Recorder read a communication from the Southern Pacific Company with reference to installing a return pipe from their water tank to the city mains, and stating that their representative would call.

Mayor Bair announced that the representative had called and had agreed to put in a requisition for funds to install the pipe.

A complaint was entered of the S.P. crossing on A street and the Recorder was instructed to ask for repairs on same.
