Regular Meeting, May 2, 1927

The regular meeting of the City Council was held on Monday, May 2, 1927 at 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Mayor Bair, City Attorney Wait, Chief of Police Lent, Recorder H.B. Evans and Councilmen Bowlsby, Dedman, Garrett, Graham, Patch, Shewey, White and Zimmerman.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Communications.

A petition from the Canby Cooperative Telephone Association asking for new franchise was read and referred to the City Attorney for some changes.

A communication from the Southern Pacific Co. asking for a conference with regard to road easement to Molalla River was read, and on motion, seconded and carried, the Recorder was instructed to make arrangement for Monday, May 9 at 10 o'clock A.M.

Whereupon a communication from the P.E.P. Co. of Portland was presented and read in which they offered to assume the bonded indebtedness of \$ 32000. and pay \$ 13000. cash for the Electric Light and Water Systems of Canby. This occasioned a somewhat lengthy discussion, and the Mayor called for an expression from the members of the Council, which resulted as follows:
