The Mayor announced that the meeting was called for the purpose of canvassing the votes of the recent election.

Whereupon the Recorder read the following results:

To the Hon. Mayor and City Council of Canby. Gentlemen:

At a Special City Election held in Canby, in the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, on the 23rd. day of July , 1927 on the

following question:

"Shall Canby accept the proposition of the Portland Electric
Power Company to purchase from Canby it's Electric Light and Power System
and Water System, paying Canby therefor the sum of Forty five thousand
dollars, so much of said sum as necessary to be used in assuming and liquidating the outstanding bonds and warrants unpaid against said Electric Light and Power System and Water System, and the Balance to be paid to Canby in cash." The result was as follows:

13 No I vote not to sell the Systems 130 Blank
