Whereupon the Light Committee stated that the nightwatchman should report promptly any street lights out of commission, as complaints had been made that replacements were too long delayed.

On motion, seconded and carried, it was voted that the nightwatchman be requested to turn off street lights, and to report promptly to the Chief of Police, any lights out of commission.

The Recorder was instructed to notify the nightwatchman to this effect.

Whereupon the Chairman of the Fire and Water Committee reported that all arrangements had been made to lay larger pipe line into the Fair Grounds, the old pipe to remain the property of the City.

Whereupon the Mayor reported on the proposed new street to new Union High School site, stating that Mr. J.J.Sandsness, Chairman of a committee from the Commercial Club on this matter, had reported that all adjacent property owners were willing to donate rights of way.

Sept. 7-continued.

Whereupon it was moved, seconded and carried that an Engineer be employed by the Committee on Streets and Public Property to survey for the proposed road to the school site, and have a plat of same to present to the Council.

Whereupon it was moved by Shewey, seconded by Patch that the City purchase two fire extinguishers from Mr. Gribble, at \$ 18.00 each . Motion carried.

Whereupon Mr. Kronberg and Mr. Elliott, residents of the east side of the City reported that the road forming a part of the boundary of the City limits was in a deplorable condition, and that as soon as the rainy season commenced would be impassable.

Work asked for. No action.

The following citizens were appointed to serve as a Budget Committee to prepare a budget for the City for the following year (1927)
