

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL JULY 6TH,
1925.

Council called to order by the Mayor W. H. Bair at 8:00 P.M.
o'clock.

Upon roll call their were present Mayor W. H. Bair, City Attorney C. N. Wait, Recorder C. L. Eid, Chief of Police Louis Lent, Councilmens Bowlsby, Dedman, Patch, Shewey, Swanby, Wanr and White. Absent Councilman Evans.

Whereupon the minutes of the last regular meeting was read and approved as read.

Whereupon the letter from the County Judge was read relative to the approximate cost of paving the road from Goods Bridge to the Pacific Highway.

Whereupon the Treasurers report for the second quarter was read.

Whereupon it was moved and seconded that the Treasurers report be laid on the table until the next regular meeting. Motion carried.

Whereupon the following ordinance was read:

ORDINANCE NO. 200... 1925-2

An ordinance providing for the Mayor and Recorder to enter into and sign a contract with the County Court of Clackamas County, wherein the City of Canby agrees to pay the said County Court for paving that part of the Marquam and Canby Market Road that lies within the City Limits of Canby.

CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to sign a contract with the County Court of Clackamas County, agreeing to pay the said County Court, for paving that part of the Marquam and Canby Market Road, that lies within the City Limits of Canby, the amount and terms of said payment to be set forth in the contract hereinafter to be made with said County Court.

Whereupon it was moved and seconded that this ordinance pass its first reading and was ordered posted. Motion carried.

Whereupon it was moved and seconded that the Mayor and Recorder be empowered to enter into a contract with the County Court to pave the Marquam and Canby Market Road that lies within

the city limits of Canby. Motion Carried.
