

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CANBY, OREGON

HELD August 3rd, 1925.

Council called to order by the Mayor W. H. Bair at 8:00 o'clock P.M.

Upon roll call there were present Mayor W. H. Bair, City Attorney C. N. Wait, Recorder C. L. Eid, Chief of Police Louis Lent, Councilmens, Bowlsby, Evans, Patch, Shewey, Swanby and White. Absent Councilmens Dedman and Wang.

Whereupon the minutes of the last regular meeting was read and approved as read.

Whereupon the communication from the State Industrial Accident Commission was read notifying the City of Canby's rating would be a reduction of 20% instead of the increase of 15% commencing July 1st, 1925.

Whereupon the petition of the Pastime Pool & Billiard Hall was read asking for permission to play pool and Billiards on Sunday afternoons.

Whereupon the letter and remonstrance petitions was read.

Whereupon the following Ordinance was read for final passage:

ORDINANCE NO. 100 1925

An ordinance providing for the Mayor and Recorder to enter into and sign a contract with the County Court of Clackamas County, wherein the City of Canby agrees to pay the said County Court for paving that part of the Marquam and Canby Market Road that lies within the City Limits of Canby.

CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to sign a contract with the County Court of Clackamas County, agreeing to pay the said County Court, for paving that part of the Marquam and Canby Market Road, that lies within the limits of Canby, the amount and terms of said payment to be set forth in the contract hereinafter to be made with said County Court.

Read for the first time at a regular meeting of the City Council held July 6th, 1925 and ordered posted for in the opinion of the City Council the cost of publication was excessive and to come up for final passage at a regular meeting of the City Council held August 3rd, 1925 at 8:00 o'clock P.M.

Whereupon it was moved and seconded that the ordinance be placed on its final passage. Motion carried. Upon roll call ayes 6. Nos 0.
