Whereupon the Finance Committee reported that the Highway Commission were wanting a payment of \$600.00 due on paving of Pacific Highway through the City of Canby.

Whereupon the Mayor appointed the Finance Committee, the Street Supt. A.H. Knight and the City Attorney C.N. Wait as a Committee to go to Salem and interview the Highway commission with the view of effecting a settlement.

Whereupon the following Tax levying Ordinance was read:

ORDINANCE NO. 201

An ordinance for the purpose of levying a tax on all taxable property, both real and personal, within Canby and declaring an emergency.

CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Canby does hereby levy a tax of \$4,900.00 on all the taxable property, both real and personal, which is taxable for County and State purposes, within the corporate limits of Canby, which is to be collected as other taxes are collected in the State of Oregon, by the Sheriff and Tax Collector of Clackamas County, during the year 1926, with the Taxes commonly known as the taxes for 1925. Said levy shall consist of \$3,360.00 known as the regular City tax and \$1,540.00 special taxes heretofore approved by the voters of Canby.

Section 2. Whereas, it is necessary that Canby shall raise the sum of money aforesaid to meet the expenses of the City and protect the health and safety of the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its final passage and approved by the Mayor.

Read for the first time at a regular meeting of the Council held on October 5th, 1925, and ordered posted for the reason that the cost of publication thereof is excessive in the opinion of the Council, and to come up for hearing of the Council to be held November 2nd, 1925.

Whereupon the Water Supt. Louis Lent reported to the Council that the City Water Tank was in bad order, in that it was settling again and the tank itself was becoming rotted.

Whereupon the Mayor instructed the Committee on Fire and Water to investigate the water tower and tank and report back at the next regular meeting of the City Council.

Whereupon it was moved and seconded that the Council adjourn. Motion carried.
