SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANBY, OREGON held November 18th, 1925.

Whereupon the Mayor stated that the Council was called for the purpose of considering the proposition of erecting a new City Water Tower and Tank and also considering the agreement drawn up by the Molalla Electric Co. to permit the Molalla Elec. Co. to use the City of Canby's poles in stringing up a fourth wire to serve their surburban customers.

Upon roll call their were present Mayor W. H. Bair, Recorder C. L. Eid, Chief of Police Louis Lent, Councilmens Bowlsby, Evans, Patch, Shewey, Swanby, Wang and White. Absent City Attorney C. N. Wait, and Councilman Dedman.

Whereupon the several communications from Tank and Tower Companys were read and considered after which they were orderd filed with the Recorder for future reference.

Whereupon the Committee on Fire & Water were instructed to go to Woodburn, Oregon, for information, it being understood

that Woodburn had a new Steel Tank and Tower similar to what was considered by the Council.

Whereupon it was moved and seconded that the City Attorney be instructed to draw up an ordinance to call a special election for voting bonds to erect a new Tower and tank in the amount of blank dollars, The Council to insert the needed amount, to be read at the next regular meeting of the City Council. Motion carried.

Whereupon the agreement drawn up by the Molalla Electric Co. was read, and considered by the Council.

It was moved and seconded that the agreement be refered to the City Attorney for advice. Motion carried.

Whereupon it was moved and seconded that the Council adjourn. Motion carried.
