Whereupon the following ordinance was read;

ORDINANCE NO. 198

An ordinance providing for the use and regulation of  
vehicles on the streets, Roads and Highways of Canby, pro-  
viding for the punishment of violation of this act, and  
prohibiting the unauthorized use of said vehicles.

Canby does ordain as follows;  
Section 1.

Definition of terms: the term street as used in  
this act shall mean every public way, thoroughfare and place  
including bridges, streets, alleys and roads within Canby used  
or intended for use of the General public for vehicles.  
The term vehicle shall mean every mechanical device moving by  
other power than human power over the streets as herein defined.

Section 2. No vehicle shall be parked or left to stand on  
the streets of Canby unless the right hand wheels thereof are  
within one foot of the curb, and shall not park or discharge  
passengers so that any part of said wheel projects into any  
cross street when so parked or discharging passengers; and  
further providing that all vehicles parked on the south side  
of Front Street shall stand parallel with the pavement and  
shall have all four wheels off from the pavement.

Section 3. No vehicle shall be parked or left standing within fifteen feet of any fire hydrant in Canby.

Section 4. No vehicle shall turn on the streets of Canby except at the intersections of the streets thereof.

Section 5. Any person violating any of the provisions of this act shall upon conviction thereof, before the Recorder or Mayor of Canby, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined not more than to exceed one hundred dollars, or imprisonment not to exceed thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.

Read for the first time at a regular meeting of the Council held January 4th, 1925, and ordered posted for the reason that the cost of publication thereof is excessive in the opinion of the Council, and to come up for final passage February 2nd 1925.
