

## SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

CANBY, OREGON held May 18th 1925.

The Council was called to order at 8:00 P.M. by the Mayor  
W. H. Bair.

Upon roll call there were present Mayor W. H. Bair,  
Recorder C. L. Eid, Councilmens Bowsby, Evans, Patch,  
Shewey, Swanby, Wang and White. Absent City Attorney C.  
N. Wait, Chief of Police Louis Lent, and Councilman  
Dedman.

Whereupon the Mayor stated the purpose of the meeting  
was for granting the Canby Civic Club the permission to  
erect a marker that would advertise as well as beautify  
the City of Canby.

Whereupon it was moved and seconded that the City  
Attorney be instructed to draw up a resolution granting  
the Canby Civic Club the permission to construct a marker  
to advertise the City of Canby along the Highway within  
Canby, Oregon.

Whereupon the following resolution was drawn up;

The following resolution was introduced by Council-  
man White and its adoption moved, upon being duly seconded,  
The Resolution was adopted by unanimous vote of the Council:

Resolved that Canby grant to the Womans Civic Club of  
Canby the privilage of erecting and maintaining a Marker  
EACH SIDE OF  
of "C" Street ~~South~~ on the Pacific Highway in Canby, Oregon.

Whereupon it was moved and seconded that the Council  
adjourn. Motion carried.
