

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF CANBY, OREGON. Held October
6th, 1924, at 8:00 P.M.

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER BY THE MAYOR, W. S. MAPLE.

Upon roll call there were present W. S. Maple, Mayor; C. L. Eid, Recorder; Louis Lent, Chief of Police; Councilman: Bowlsby; Dedman; Johnson; Shull; Swanby; Absent: Councilman: Bair; Sheldon; and Weygandt.

Whereupon the resignations of Councilmans Sheldon and Weygandt were read. It was moved and seconded that the resignations of Councilman Sheldon and Weygandt be excepted. Motion Carried.

Whereupon it was moved and seconded that there be elected two Councilman to fill the vacancy caused by the resignations of Councilman Sheldon and Weygandt, to serve to Dec. 31st, 1924. Motion Carried.

Whereupon C. P. Shewey and Horace Patch were nominated. There being no further nominations, it was moved and seconded that the nominations be closed. Result of the first ballot: C. P. Shewey 5; Horace Patch 5; C. P. Shewey and Horace Patch having received the majority of all voted cast they were declared duly elected by the Mayor.

Whereupon C. P. Shewey and Horace Patch being present they were duly sworn in by the Recorder and seated in the body of the Council.

Whereupon the Treasurers Report for the third quarter was read. It was moved and seconded that the Treasurers Report for the third quarter be adopted as read and spread upon the minutes. Motion Carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 196

An ordinance for the purpose of levying a tax on all taxable property, both real and personal, within Canby and declaring an emergency.

CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Canby does hereby levy a tax of \$4780.00 on all the taxable property, both real and personal, which is taxable for County and State purposes, within the corporate limits of Canby, which is to be collected as other taxes are collected in the State of Oregon, by the Sheriff and Tax Collector of Clackamas County, during the year 1925, with the taxes commonly known as the taxes of 1924. Said levy shall consist of \$3180.00 known as the regular City tax and \$1600.00 special taxes heretofore approved by the voters of Canby.

Section 2. Whereas, it is necessary that Canby shall raise the sum of money aforesaid to meet the expenses of the City and protect the health and safety of the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its final passage and approved by the Mayor.

READ for the first time at a regular meeting of the Council held on October 6, 1924, and ordered posted for the reason that the cost of publication thereof is excessive in the opinion of the Council, and to come up for hearing of the Council to be held November 3, 1924.

Whereupon the following Ordinance was read:

ORDINANCE NO. 197 1924-6

An ordinance providing for the use and regulation of vehicles on the streets and highways of Canby, providing for the punishment of violation of this act and prohibiting the unauthorized used of such vehicles.

Canby does ordain as follows:

Section 1. definition of terms: the term street, as

used in this act, shall mean every public way, thoroughfare and place, including bridges, streets, alleys, and roads within Canby, used or intended for the use of the general public for vehicles.

The term vehicle shall mean every mechanical device moving by other power than human power, over the Streets as herein defined.

Section 2. No vehicle shall park on the paved portion of the streets of Canby, unless the right-hand wheels thereof are against the curb and shall not park, discharge passengers so that any part of such vehicle projects into any cross street, while so parked, discharging or taking on passengers.

Section 3. Any person violating any provisions of this act shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder or Mayor of Canby, be guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined not to exceed \$100.00 or imprisonment not to exceed thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.

It was thereupon moved and seconded that said reading would be considered the first reading and said ordinance was ordered posted for the reason that the charges of publication were, in the judgement of the Council, excessive; that said ordinance come up for final passage at a regular meeting of the Council held for that purpose on the 3rd day of ~~October~~ **NOVEMBER** 1924, at 8:00 P.M. o'clock.
