ORDINANCE NO 143

Section 1. It is hereby declared to be the purpose of the City of Canby to build a fire truck adequate for all emergencies.

Section 2. The recorder and the mayor of the City of Canby are hereby delegated to pay in the usual manner for the Ford Chasis in the amount of \$432.00.

Section 3. In so much as there is an urgent need of a motor drawn fire apparatus and is necessary for the peace, quiet and health of said city, and emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its adoption and approval.

Whereupon the 6ity marshal was instructed to renew the ringing of the curfew and to round up all dogs according to our ordinances.
