On roll call for passage of motion: Ayes: Bowlsby, Bair, Johnson and Swanby. Noes: Shull and Weygandt. Whereupon the Mayor declared said motion adopted.

Whereupon the following Ordinance was read:

*Ordinance #103 An Ordinance to provide for the purchase of a Ford chassis from the J.W. White Motor Company for a Fire Truck and declare an emergency.*

It was moved and seconded that such Ordinance be adopted.

Noes: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared such Ordinance duly passed and immediately approved a copy thereof.

It was moved and seconded that the water superintendant put a water meter on the Cannery and report to the Council the amount of water that they use so that a flat rate could be determined. Motion carried.

It was moved and seconded that the City Council go on record as favorable to the action of the Ladies Civic Club in their efforts to beautify the city and that a letter of thanks be sent them. Motion carried.
