Whereupon the following Ordinance was
read:

ORDINANCE NO. 180

An Ordinance to provide for the payment of \$108.10 to the Molalla Electric Company.

CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The sum of \$108.10 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to pay the Molalla Electric Company for electric current for the month of July 1921.

It was moved and seconded that said reading be considered the first reading, ~~and that it be adopted,~~ and that it be posted for the reason that the cost of publication thereof in the opinion of the Council was excessive; said ordinance to come up for final passage at a regular meeting of the Council of Canby, to be held November 7, 1921. Motion Carried.

Whereupon, the following Ordinance was read, entitled:

"An Ordinance providing for the purchase and payment of 440 yards of gravel at a cost of \$2.25 per yard."

After the election it was declared by the Mayor that H. C.
Sheldon had been duly elected to fill the unexpired term
of Ora Slyter, by the Council.

It was moved and seconded that an extension
of ninety days be extended to J. Lee Eckerson, Treasurer of
the City of Canby, as a leave of absence. Motion carried.
