The council was called to order by Mayor A.H.Knight, the retiring Mayor and after roll call the Mayor-Elect was duly sworn in and the Retiring Mayor turned the council over to Mayor W.S.Maple.

Those voting aye were Bair, Dedman, Eid, Evans, Johnson, Sandsness Shull and Slyter. Voting No None. Moved that bill of G.F.Meeks for balance due as Water Supt. for November 1920 of \$50.00 be laid over for further action by the Council.

The council proceeded to ballot for the election for the President of the Council. Result of the first ballot John Eid 7, H.B.Evans 1, whereupon the Mayor declared John Eid duly elected President of the Council.

It was moved and seconded that Recorder C.N.Waits resignation be accepted. Upon motion Council proceeded to elect a City Recorder to fill vacancy then existing. Upon roll call C.L.Eid having recieved eight votes, being the votes of all present was declared elected Recorder and was duly sworn in. The mayor then announced the appointments of the standing committees as follows;

Finance- Bair, Eid and Evans,.

Fire and Water, Eid, Shull and Slyter.

Health and Police- Dedman, Evans and Sandsness.

Streets and Public Property- Johnson, Shull and Slyter.

Chief of Police- G.F.Meeks.

There being no further business the Council then adjourned.
