

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL,  
Canby, Oregon. January 29th, 1921.

A special meeting of the City Council was called to order at 8 o'clock P.M. January the 29th 1921 by Mayor W.S. Maple.

On roll call the following were present; Mayor W.S. Maple, Marshall G.F. Weeks, Recorder C.L. Eid, Councilmen Bair, Dedman, Eid, Johnson, Sandsness, Shull and Slyter. Councilman Evans being absent.

The Mayor announced the purpose of the meeting was to consider the analysis of water as recieved from the State Board of Health.

It was moved and seconded that the City Recorder post notices that no person or persons shall use any water coming from the City Water Works without first being boiled for drinking purposes or for the washing of vegetables. Motion carried.

Moved and seconded that the Chairman of the committee on Health and Police secure samples of water from the City Wells and Mains and submit them to the State Board of Health for analysis and to report their findings as soon as report was recieved. Motion carried.

There being no further business the council ajourned.
