

REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL

March 7, 1921.

On roll call, the following officers were present:

W. S. Maple, Mayor, Clarence Eid, Recorder, Philip Hammond, City Attorney, George Meeks, Chief of Police, and Councilmen, Eid, Sandsness, Evans, Dedman, Shull, Johnson and Slyter.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Recorder was instructed to write to Rosen-
and
cranz and Company, in regard to water rent,-that the water rent be collected from them, by the Water Collectors.

It was moved and seconded, that churches be exempt from paying water rents. Carried.

It was moved and seconded, that T. B. Hamilton's resignation as Street Superintendent be accepted. Carried.

A letter regarding the surety premium on August Rothenburg's bond, as Night Policeman, was read, and the Council instructed the Recorder to have all the City Officials' bonds fixed up, and presented to the Mayor for approval, and that the Council would pay the surety bond premiums.

The Committee on Streets and public property was instructed to inspect the property, to see that the water supply of Canby was not polluted, and to give such notice as would be necessary to remove nuisances; also to see that the electric wires did not hang on telephone wires in the City.
