Adjourned meeting of City Council.

Council met in adjourned session and called to order at 8 O'clock P.M. by Mayor A.H. Knight,

There were present Mayor Knight, Recorder Wait, Marshall Bowman and City Attorney Hammond, and Councilmen Combs, Evans, Eid, Fedman, Sandness, Slyter and White. Mr White from the Committee on Streets to whom the matter was referred recommending that all bids received for the proposed street improvements be rejected, the report of the Committee was received and the Committee discharged from further consideration of the matter. Upon a motion duly made, seconded and carried the Council then declared all bids rejected.

A Communication was read by Mr Carrow City Engineer from the S.P. Ry Co saying they would allow the City to go ahead and construct the "C" Street sidewalk as proposed across the Ry Property.

This being the time set for the consideration of the 1921, Budget as reported by the finance committee it was moved seconded and carried that the sum of \$550.00. proposed in the Budget for changing Electric Light System be cut out. The following Budget for the year 1921, was then adopted and passed by the unanimous vote of the Council, to wit;
