The Marshall reported that Mr Coo Kochler of the telephone company complained that they could not set telephone poles on account of the alley in block No One being blocked by Mr Andy Kochers hen house, Committe on streets asked to see Mr Kochler and Mr Kocher and see if they could not arrange the matter satisfactory to all. In the matter of connecting the property of Mr Shull with the water main the Nater Supt was instructed to lay a pipe across the street to Mr Shull's property line.

Marshall Berman asked the Council for an increase in his pay and stated that he could not continue to work for the City unless his pay was increased, he thought he had ought to receive at least \$20.

a menth more pay. Upon motion duly made, seconded and carried for Bermans pay was increased \$20. per menth as Marshall.

Mr Bewman stated that some of the citizens of Camby thought the safety of property in Camby demanded the appointment of a night wat chman, and had raised the sum of about \$60.per menth for that purpose by subscription, and asked the Council to contribute what they exceeded, upon metion duly made, seconded and carried the Council agreed to pay the sum of \$10.per menth, for that purpose for a period of not over six menths, Thereupon Mr Aug Rethemberg was appointed night watchman, the appointment to take effect upon the filing of a good and sufficient bend to the City by Mr Rethemberg.

April 19th 1920, which said notices of election shall state the date upon which said election shall be held and shall designate the purpose of said election, the polling place thereof, and the hours that the said polls shall be open, and shall name the judges and Clerks of the sai said election and give the ballet title of the proposed Act to be submitted to a vote of the electors of Camby, for their adoption or rejection at said special City election.

section 3. The Council of Camby shall by metion hereafter appoarpeint judges and clerks of said special CT y election, that said judges and clerks shall receive as full compensation for their services as such, the sum of three dollars per day each.

Section 4. The election ward or precinct for said special city election shall be and constitute all of the territory included within the corporate limits of Camby.

section 5. There shall be one polling place for said special city election, to wit; in the Council chamber of the City of Camby.
