Under report of officers Marshall Bowman said people were complaining of the way Stephanie had lumber piled obstructing road and sidewalk Moved by Evans and seconded by Eid that marshal instruct Stefanie to remove lumber. The mayor stated that Mr. Kesselring wished street on east of his property reduced from eighty feet. Mayor stated that complaints were made that trains obstructed crossings too long.
