Canby dees Ordain as fellews Section I.

That the City of Camby does hereby levy a tax upon all the taxable preperty, both real and personal which is taxable for State and County purposes, within the Corporate limits of Camby, to be collected as other taxes are collected in the State of Oregon by the Treasurer and tax collector of Clackamas County, during the year 1920, with the taxes commonly known as the taxes of 1919.

It was moved, seconded and carried that said Ordinance be posted for the reason that the charges of publication thereof are in the judg ment of the Council excessive and that publication be dispensed with, and that the same shall be pested in three public and conspi cueus places for a period of two full callender weeks, and to come up for final passage at a regular mosting of the Council of Canby. to be held on the 3rd day of November 1919.
