

## Adjourned meeting of the City Council.

Canby Oregon October 13th 1919.

Council met in adjourned sessio and called to order by the Mayor at 8 o'clock P.M.

There were present Mayor A.H. Knight, Recorder C.W. Wait Marshall C. E. Bowman, and Councilmen Combs, Bowlby, Sandsnes, Padman and White. The question of a budget being taken up, after discussion the following budget for the year 1920, for the City of Canby was determined on, to be submitted to a meeting of the citizens of Canby at a budget meeting to be held at the City Hall at 8 o'clock, on the night of October 30th 1919, and to be passed on by the City Council at it's regular meeting on November 3rd 1919, and the Recorder was instructed to have the same published for two full calender weeks in the Canby News, and also to post the same as required by law.

making the necessary sum of \$3000.00 to be raised by taxation.  
 The City Treasurer submitted a statement to the Council showing  
 that there was a balance of \$ 2293.00 cash on hand in the General  
 Fund on October 1st 1919.

The following Ordinance was then introduced, and read for the first time.

ORDINANCE NO. 144

ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE, for the purpose of levying a tax of Three thousand dollars (\$3000.00.) on all the taxable property, both real and personal within the City of Canby, Oregon.

Canby does Ordain as follows:  
 Section 1.

That the City of Canby does hereby levy a tax upon all the taxable property, both real and personal which is taxable for State and County purposes, within the Corporate limits of Canby, to be collected as other taxes are collected in the State of Oregon by the Treasurer and tax collector of Clackamas County, during the year 1920, with the taxes commonly known as the taxes of 1919.

It was moved, seconded and carried that said Ordinance be posted for the reason that the charges of publication thereof are in the judgment of the Council excessive and that publication be dispensed with, and that the same shall be posted in three public and conspicuous places for a period of two full calendar weeks, and to come up for final passage at a regular meeting of the Council of Canby, to be held on the 3rd day of November 1919.

Council thereupon adjourned.
