Slyter reports that committe did not think it advisible to buy ten horse power motor, but thought both wells should be put in condition before anything further was done, Mr. Robinson spoke about using the well across the road but it is not the property of the City, upon reguest the recorder then read the contract and aggreed submitted to the committe by Mr. Robinson, The committe strongly recommenden that something

368be done at once to increase the supply of water. It was moved and carrie edthat report of the council be accepted and committe discharged. Mr Slyter reported from special committe to see standard Cil Co adout getting Oil in quanity, that he had not been able to see the agent yet. An ordinance to pay J.J. The ordinance was declared cerried: The Council them proceeded to elect a president of the coincil, John Eid having received four votes was elected President of the Council: C.E. Bowman was then elected Superintendant of the water department, unaminously.

D.R. Dermick having received four votes was declared elected Supt. of Streets, C.N.Wait was declared elected city Recorder unamiously. C. H. Bowman was then appointed Chief of Police by the Mayor elect, subject to the filling and approvel of his office bond, The Mayor then announced the appointment of the standing committee as follows.

Finance... Evans, Eid, Combs.

Streets & Public Property ... Bowlsby, Sansness, White. Fire and Water ... Eid, White. Slyter.

Health and Police... Dedman, Slyter, Sansness.

The Mayor then addressed the Council on the duties of the Mayor and Councilmen to the City, It was moved that \$55%. OObe transferred from the general fund to the water fund, The Mayor them called the President of he Council, John 216 of the Chair while he spoke on the Motion, after w

whitch the motion was carried. The Finance Committe was instructed to make an examination of the financial condition of the water department and report to the Council, there being nothing furtyer the Council

adjourned.
