Those voting aye were Combs, Evans, Eld, Sandsness, Slyter and White. Mr. Slyter of comm. on oil turned in communication from Standard Oil Co. and Union Oil Co in regard to price of fuel and lubricating oil, Mr. Slyter found the Aristo oil, Mr. Slyter also said we could get it from the local garage Mr. White as cheap as of the Co. Moved that the fire and water committee make a contract with the Union oil Co. to supply the City with the necessary fuel oil for one year. Carried.

Report of standing committee on fire and water, Mr. Slyter reported that they had not done anything in particular in regard to pumps and wells as yet, but intend to go ahead in regard to the matter.

The question in regard to the repair of electric light brackets referred to committee on streets and public property.

The following ordinance to pay Hammond and Hammond \$150.00 for legal services in the case of Hornig vs Canby, was placed on file and read for the first time and ordered posted for the reason that the cost of publication was excessive in the judgement of the Council, and was to come up for final passage at the regular meeting of the Council March 3rd 1919

Ordinance No. 113

An ordinance providing for the payment of Hammond & Hammond for services which they have rendered the city of Canby and appropriating the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars therefor.

Canby does ordain as follows.

1. Whereas heretofore an action was commenced in the Circuit Court of Clackamas County, Oregon by Peter Hornig against the City of Canby, at which time Philip L. Hammond was City Attorney of Canby and services have been rendered since that time in defending said suit by Hammond & Hammond, who have not received any compensation therefor.

2. The sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the City of Canby in payment of the services which have been rendered the City of Canby, by Hammond and Hammond, in defending the suit of Peter Hornig vs Canby.

Read for the first time and ordered posted at a regular meeting of the Council of the City of Canby, held on the third day of February, 1919 and to come for final passage at a regular meeting of the Council at the City of Canby, to be held on the 3rd. day of March, 1919.

There being no further business the Council adjourned.
