

Canby, Oregon, May 5th 1919.

Regular meeting of the Council.

Council met in regular session and called to order by Mayor A.H. Knight at 8:30, P.M.

Present: A.W. Knight Mayor, C.N. Wait Recorder, C. E. Bowman Marshall, and Councilmen Bowlsby Combs, Dedman, Eid, Evans, Sandsness and White.

Minutes of meeting of April 7th read and approved as read.

Marshall Bowman reported that the party on the Craser place had decided that he did not want the City water put in the place so nothing had been done in the matter. The following bills against the City were then read and upon motion duly seconded ordered paid and warrants drawn for the same.

These voting aye on the above bills were, Bowby, Combs, Dedman, Eid, Evans, Sandsness and White. Mr M.J. Lee then handed to the Recorder an ordinance which he wished read to the Council and asked that some action be taken on it, after being read b the Council it was moved seconded and carried that the matter be referred to the Committee on streets and public property for action. Mr Evans from the finance committee reported on the receipts and expenditures of the City water plant as follows: For the year 1918,

Receipts \$2289.58.

Expenses \$2922.19. leaving a deficit of \$632.61. for the year. The

Mayer stated that he thought it was full time that a move be started to provide a fund for the paving of Front street, from A to E, s street moved and carried that the Mayer appoint a committee of one to find out the necessesary steps to be taken to provide legally for the paving of said street. The Mayer then appointed the City Recorder as such Committee. Mr Evans from the committee reported that the City could get a place to dump garbage from A Steffani at a cost of about \$50.00. per year. Moved by Mr Evans that the committee be instructed to confer with the Railroad Company and see if the City could get permission to dump the City garbage on their property provided the City would burn all the garbage, and that if such permission could not be obtained to make a contract for one year to use the Steffani place as a dumping ground, at not to exceed \$50.00 a year. carried. Councilman Dedman thought that the principal street should be oiled, upon metien the committee on streets and public property was instructed to inquire into the matter and if they thi nk it advisable to go ahead and oil streets. There being no further business Council then adjourned.
