Canby, Oregon, June 2nd 1919.

Council met in regular session on June 2nd 1919, and called to order at 8 o'clock P.M. by Mayor A.H. Knight.

Present: Mayor A.H. Knight, Recorder C.W. Vait and Marshall C.E. Bowman, and Councilmen Bowlsby, Combs, Eid, Evans and Sandsness.

Minutes of last regular and the special meeting of May 15th read and approved as read. The following bills against the City were read and upon motion duly seconded ordered paid, these voting aye were Councilmen Bowlsby, Combs, Eid, Evans and Sandsness, Voting No none.

Mr. Eid from Comm. on well reported that they thought they had well fixed and in good condition. He reported that a new cylinder was needed as old one was worn out and that new one would cost about \$217.00.

Moved by Mr Combs and seconded by Bowlsby that John Eid of well Comm. order a new cylinder to be procured as soon as possible. Carried. Comm. on street oiling, continued. Mr Evans reports that he had talked with Clarke Kendall & Co. in regard to necessary proceedings to be had in the matter of improving Front Streets as to make the bonds available for sale. Mr Evans read part of the proceedings as set forth by their attorney. Moved that the recorder notify the Oregon State Highway Comm. in reply to their letter of May 9th. that the City would grant them right of way over any city street which would be used by the Pacific Highway giving information in regard to ownership of the

property over which they would pass, inside of City limits.
Mr. Evans read a letter from P. L. Hammond in regard to insurance
policy in which Mr. Hammond wants pay of 17.50 for time the policy was
in operation as he claims. Moved that the matter be laid on the
table. Carried. Moved that the Council adjourn to June 18th. 1919

Adjourned meeting of Council from June 2nd 1919.

Council met and called to order by Mayor A.H. Knight
at 8 30 O'clock P.M.. Present Mayor A.H. Knight, Recorder C.N. Wait
Marshall C.E. Bowman and Councilmen Bowsby, Combs, Redman, Eid, Evans, Whit
and Sandness. Moved by Evans and seconded by Eid that the Council do
proceed to the election of a City Engineer carried whereupon Mr E.C.
Robinson having received a majority of the votes cast when the ballot
was taken for that position, Mr Robinson was declared duly elected City
Engineer. After some discussion of the matter Mr Evans was delegated to
see the firms or companies desiring to make bids for the proposed street
improvement bonds and ask them to have their Attorney present at the
next Council meeting to advise the Council as to the legal proceedings
necessary to be taken to make the proposed bonds marketable.
There being no further business the Council then adjourned.
