

SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL.

Canby, Oregon, September 30 1918.

Council met in special session, called to order by Mayor W.H. Bair at 8 O'clock P.M. Present Mayor Bair, Records C.W. Hatt and Street Comsnr W.H. Evans, and Councilmen H.A. Readman, Ora J. Ytter, C.C. Combs, L.H. Van Lang and C.W. White. Bids were received and read from the Clackamas County Banner and Oregon City Enterprise for the printing of the special election pamphlet, The Enterprise being the only bid that complied with the law, upon motion the bid for printing 500 of the pamphlet's was given to it at the price of \$19.80.

Street Comsnr W.H. Evans reported that A. Steffani had failed to repair his sidewalk in the manner and at the time he was notified to,

There being no further business the Council then adjourned.
