## Regular Meeting of the Council.

Council met at 7.30, P.M., and called to order by Mayor W.M.

Bair. Present Mayor Bair, Recorder C.N.Wait, Chief of Police C.E.Bowman and Councilmen L.H.Wang, C.C.Combs, H.B.Evans, John Eid, Ora Slighter, W.A.

Redman and C.W.White. Minutes of last regular and special meetings of November 7th read and approved as read.

The Recorder then read the following Ordinance;

## ORDINANCE NO 142

An Ordinance appropriating \$150.00 out of the General Fund of the City of Canby, to pay the bill of Joseph E. Hedges for legal services in the case of Hornig vs Canby.

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Section I That there be appropriated and drawn out of the General Fund of the City of Canby, Oregon, the sum of \$150.00 to pay for legal services of Joseph E. Hedges, in the case of Hornig vs Canby.

Motion made seconded and carried that said reading be considered the first reading, and that said Ordinance be posted for the reason that the cost of publication thereof was in the judgment of the Council excessive, said publication was dispensed with, and the same shall be posted in three public and conspicuous places for a period of two full calendar weeks, and to come up for final passage at the regular meeting of the Council, January 6th 1919.

Bills against the city were presented as follows and ordered paid, Those voting Aye were: Councilmen Wang, Combs, Evans, Eid and Slighter.

On motion Ora Slyter appointed a committee to see Standard Oil Co, and see about making a contract for purchasing oil for a certain length of time at a less rate than the City is paying at present. Mr Robinson addressed the Council at some length on the subject of the City purchasing a motor and power from him to aid in part or wholly, the present pumping plant, moved seconded and carried that the Mayor appoint a committee of three to further confer with Mr Robinson in the matter: Thereupon the Mayor appointed as such committee, John Eid, Ora Slyter and C.E. White. Moved seconded and carried that a resolution be sent to the victory memorial Committee endorsing the Victory Highway between Portland and Salem on the West side of the Willamette river, passing through Canby. Mayor Bair then extended his thanks to the members of the Council for their aid and assistance to him in the past and wished them good luck and success in the future. Council then adjourned.
