

Regular MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

Canby, Oregon, Feb 4th 1918.

A regular meeting of the city Council was held Feb. 4th. 1918, and was called to order by Mayor W. H. Bair, at 8 o'clock P.M.

Upon roll call the following were present, Mayor W. H. Bair, Recorder J. L. Eckerson, Marshal E. E. Bowman, Councilman L. H. Vanf, C. C. Combs, C. W. White, H. A. Dedman, and John Eid.

Minutes of January 7th. read and approved, as read.

Upon motion Council proceeded to elect a City Recorder to fill the vacancy then existing upon roll call Chas N. Wait having received five votes, being the votes of all present was declared elected Recorder and was then sworn in.

Mayor Bair reported that the S. P. Ry Co. wished to obtain water for its engines and the matter was referred to the water committee and the Recorder was instructed to write the superintendent of the water system of both Salem and Oregon City and ask them as to the price they received from the S. P. Ry Co. for water and the system by which the Co. obtained the water, and the Recorder was to turn the answer to the Water committee of Canby; Acting Recorder J. L. Eckerson made an oral report as to finances of the city and promised to have a written financial report ready for the council in a few days, when the Mayor was to call an adjourned meeting of the council to consider the report.

Street supt. was instructed to notify propertyholders to repair defective sidewalks within five days after notice or if not done for superintendant to repair and charge to property owner.

Street supt. instructed to put in gravel walk accross street by Methodist church instead of plank. and to repair crossing opposite Whites garageto R'y. crossing and on other side in front of Mrs Bradfords.

Mr. M. J. Lee then talked a while objecting to the amount allowed him by the council for alleged services about city well

No further buisness appearing the council then adjourned to meet at call of the Mayor.
