REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL.

A regular meeting of the city council was held March 4th. 1918, and was called to order by Mayor W. H. Bair, at 8 o'clock p. m.

On roll call the following were present Mayor W.H.Bair, Recorder Chas. N.Wait, Marshal, C.E.Bowman, Street Coms'r Wilson Evans, Councilman L.H. Wang, C.C.Combs, C.W. White, H.A.Dedman, John Eld and H.B.Evans.

Minutes of Feb. 4th. were read and approved in regard to letter of attorney Latorette in the matter of the claim of Millord Lee against Canby, referred to water committee in regard to selling water for engine use to S.P.Co. Recorder instructed to notify Company that City of Canby would furnish water on reasonable terms, and to have Company set time when the water Committee could meet representative of Company and confer on the matter.

Those voting in favor were Yang, Combs, White, Redman, Eld, and Evans.

Recorder instructed to notify Mr. Brown S.P. Agent that City surrendered lease of sand bin last year and had no further use for it

Committee on streets reported they had put in cement cross walk instead of gravel one, next to Methodist Church.

Chief of Police reported that he got two blocks and rope from Mr Cobb for fire house purpose.

Street Coms'r asked as to what kind of walk to put in on south side of Rail road in west end of town, instructed to put in plank. Recorder was instructed to write to the S.P. R'y. Co. and notify them to put in good order the R'y. crossings in Canby notifying them that they were in verry bad condition and to repair them at once, also to remove pile of rubbish from "C" Street and to put in side walks ~~also~~ on west side of "C" Street and East side of "E" street also say that the street comitte would like to meet their representative and confer in regard to side walks,

Recorder to notify Treasurer that Council would like him to have his financial report ready for next Council meeting.

Mayou was asked to see Jos. Larson and see if satisfactory terms could be made with him to do the collecting of the City water rents.

Recorder to write and ask Hammond to send some city Charters, if any in his possession. Council then adjourned.
