April 1st 1918.

Council met and called to order by Mayor W.H. Bair. Present Mayor W.H. Bair, Recorder C.N. Wait, Chief of Police C.E. Bowman Street Commissioner H.V. Evans and Councilmen L.H. Wigg, C.W. White, John Eid, H.B. Evans, H.A. Dedman and C.C. Combs. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved. Mayor reported that Mr Larson could not do the collecting of City water rents. The Marshall was then instructed to collect the delinquent water rents. The following bills against the City were presented and read.

Committee on Streets to investigate the matter of procuring dumping grounds for City garbage. Chief of Police to notify all users of garbage cans that nothing but paper be put in the cans. Recorder instructed to see Mr Hammond in regard to Change of City Charter so as to comply with present State Laws in regard to holding City elections.
