

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Canby Oregon, May 15, 1918.

Council met and called to order by Mayor W.H. Bair. Present Mayor W.H. Bair, Recorder C.N. Wait, Marshall C.E. Bowman, Street Commissioner Wilson Evans, and Councilmen L.H. Wang, C.V. White John Eid, H.B. Evans, H. A. Deadman and C.C. Combs. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved. Communication in regard to street light at corner of Lee and Tanton streets, read and Street Committee was instructed to look into the matter, as well as a light at the street corner by Elroy Bates's corner, and act according to their best judgement. Street Supt reported that J.A. Cobb wanted pipe laid so he could have city water at his place; and agreed to take water for a year, Supt said it would take about 100 feet of pipe to get water on street where Cobb wanted to connect with it, and that the City had plenty of second hand pipe on hand for the purpose, he was instructed to furnish the pipe and let Mr Cobb dig the ditch and lay the pipe. Cobb to pay the City the usual fee for making connections. Supt. also reported his success in making collections of delinquent water dues. Treasurer to be asked to take up all outstanding water warrants for which there was money on hand to pay. The following bills against the city were presented and read.
